RICORDA CHE IN INGLESE...



- Il verbo **to like**, che è transitivo (vedi pag. 66) non è seguito solo dal complemento oggetto, ma anche dai verbi in **-ing**.
- I verbi in **-ing** che seguono il verbo **like**, possono essere tradotti in italiano all'**infinito**. Es.: *I like swimming* (mi piace nuotare), *I like fishing* (mi piace pescare).
- Anche i verbi **enjoy** e **love** (vedi pag. 66) sono seguiti dai verbi in **-ing**.

RICORDA CHE IN INGLESE...



- Il verbo **to like** significa **piacere**, è un verbo **transitivo** ed è seguito direttamente dal complemento oggetto.
Es.: *I like you* (mi piaci tu), *I like pizza* (mi piace la pizza).
- Al **simple present** si coniuga come tutti i **verbi regolari**.
- Alle **domande** con il verbo **like** si possono dare **risposte brevi** o più articolate. Es.: *Do you like fish? No, I don't. I like meat.*
- Da **like** derivano i sostantivi **likes** e **dislikes**, vale a dire "le cose che piacciono" e "le cose che non piacciono".
- In alcuni casi, **like** può essere sostituito dal verbo **enjoy**. Es.: *I like / enjoy school.*
- Quando qualcosa ti piace molto, puoi dire **I like it very much!** o **I love it!**
Se qualcosa non ti piace affatto puoi dire **I don't like it at all!**
